SystemAPI is a comprehensive, simple to use, and reliable SOAP web service available in DNS Manager. It allows third-party software applications to interact with clients, to create and administer DNS zones and records, to backup DNS Zones, manage DNS templates, gather DNS information from remote servers, and more.

## Who Should Read ThisGuide

This reference guide is intended for developers of third-party applications designed to manage or to interact with DNS Manager via SystemAPI.

## Required Knowledge and Skills

To be able to work in this environment, developers must have:

- A good understanding of the DNS Manager functionality and terminology.
- Basic understanding of web services and how they can be used in the chosen programming language.
- Good knowledge of XML and XML Schema language (referred to as XML Schema Definition or XSD).
